On 03/02/2014 at approx. 2245 hrs. this Detective responded to a shooting at 324 Seminola Blvd., in the City of Casselberry, Seminole County. A male named "James" (James Arthur Bonomo, Jr.) called 911 to report that his roommate, later identified as Patrick Joseph Jackson had been shot by a black male named "Eric". Mr. Bonomo said Eric was an ex-roommate and was last seen in the back yard of the residence.

Once Officers arrived and cleared the residence and back yard, it was confirmed the victim, Mr. Jackson had two gunshot wounds; one to his upper left chest and one to his back left side. Mr. Jackson was transported to Orlando Regional Medical Center for treatment. Ofc. Sartwell responded to ORMC, made contact with Mr. Jackson, and conducted a brief interview with him. Mr. Jackson said earlier in the evening, a former roommate, Eric Wright, came to 324 Seminola Blvd. and inquired if another roommate was home. Mr. Jackson said he told Mr. Wright the other roommate was not home at the time and Mr. Wright left.

Mr. Jackson said a little while later, he was in the back yard and heard rustling at the side of the house. He went to see what the noise was and saw Mr. Wright. Mr. Jackson said Mr. Wright did not say anything to him but began shooting at him. Mr. Jackson indicated the first shot hit him in his left upper chest. Mr. Jackson said he got up and ran toward the house when he felt another shot hit him in his lower back. Mr. Jackson identified the person who shot him as his former roommate, Eric Wright. Mr. Jackson said he was facing Mr. Wright when he shot him and they were within five feet of one another. Mr. Jackson said he did wish to press charges against Eric Wright for shooting him. The interview was audio recorded and transferred to a CD which was submitted to CPD Property/Evidence.

The Doctor who cared for Mr. Jackson at ORMC, Joseph Ibrahim, advised the round that went through Mr. Jackson's chest struck and broke his sternum, then stopped on the lower right side of his body. Dr. Ibrahim said Mr. Jackson's lungs were bruised as a result of the impact; however, no vital organs were hit. Dr. Ibrahim said the round that struck Mr. Jackson in the back broke his pelvis but did not

strike any vital organs. Dr. Ibrahim said the two rounds would not be removed from Mr. Jackson's body.

Det. Chitty responded to the residence at 324 Seminola Blvd. and made contact with Sergeant Ball who advised he marked several shell casings in the backyard porch area and noticed blood inside the residence. A request was made for Seminole County Forensic Services to respond to process the scene. The owner of the residence, John Mai, was contacted by Casselberry Corporal Strenth and responded to the scene.

Det. Chitty first interviewed Jonathan Guzzi, who lives at 324 Seminola Blvd. and is a roommate of Mr. Jackson's. He advised he did not witness the incident but heard five to six "pops" while he was in his bedroom watching television at about 2130 hrs. He stated he had just laid down when he heard the shots. He advised he knew it was Eric Wright (suspect). Mr. Guzzi advised Mr. Wright is a former roommate who Mr. Jackson had an altercation with approximately two months ago. He was not sure what the altercation was about but mentioned Mr. Wright was weird and did stupid things like shower in the dark and walk around the house in his underwear which would cause verbal altercations with other roommates. Mr. Guzzi advised Mr. Wright was kicked out of the residence about a month ago for not paying rent, but has been coming back almost daily.

Mr. Guzzi said it was common for Mr. Jackson to spend the majority of his time on the back porch because his room was so small.

Det. Chitty interviewed James Bonomo, who also lives at 324 Seminola Blvd. and is a roommate of Mr. Jackson's. Mr. Bonomo said he was in the laundry room at the time of the shooting, and he did not hear the "pops". He added he was concerned about Mr. Wright because he had a prior altercation with him which resulted in Mr. Wright coming to his place of employment. Mr. Bonomo described Mr. Wright as bizarre and said he displayed odd behavior while he was living there. He stated Mr. Wright would shower in the dark and just stand in various common areas of the residence without reason. He went on to say Mr. Wright was a former roommate that was kicked out about a month ago. Mr. Wright collected his belongings and used a U-Haul van to transport his belongings from the residence. Mr. Bonomo stated he did not know where Mr. Wright would have taken his belongings as his only known contact is his mother who lives in Georgia. Mr. Bonomo provided Det. Chitty with her name and phone number.

Mr. Bonomo said he and Mr. Jackson were sitting on the front porch area when Mr. Wright approached them asking if another roommate was home. When they told him he wasn't, Mr. Wright walked away.

Mr. Bonomo was unaware of Mr. Wright's presence at the time of the shooting as he did not hear anything; however, based on his earlier encounter, he remembered what Mr. Wright was wearing which was a blue shirt and light colored cargo pants. He added Mr. Wright is homeless, but stays close to the Button Rd./Seminola Blvd. area.

Det. Chitty then interviewed Anthony Salerno who also lives at 324 Seminola Blvd. and is a roommate of Mr. Jackson's. Mr. Salerno advised he was in the shower during the incident and was unaware of who the suspect was. He advised he only knew the name Eric because it was told to him by other roommates on scene. Mr. Salerno advised he had only been there since February 1, 2014. He said he never noticed any confrontations between his roommates because they mostly would argue with him.

Mr. Salerno mentioned an incident which occurred on or about February 16, 2014: He said he was approached by a male subject he now understands to be Mr. Wright while Mr. Salerno was in the driveway. He stated the male asked if Patrick (Mr. Jackson) was home and then walked into the house. Mr. Salerno did not hear any conversation and just saw the male subject leave. He added he would not be able to identify this subject again.

Based on the information provided by the roommates, Mr. Bonomo was shown a photo of Eric Deshawn Wright (dob. 10/21/1984) and confirmed it was the individual who previously lived at the residence with them and came by earlier in the day asking for one of the other roommates.

Sworn statements were obtained from Jonathan Guzzi, James Bonomo, and Anthony Salerno. They were submitted to CPD Records.

Six spent shell casings were found and collected from the back yard of 322 Seminola Blvd. The casings were on a concrete pad approximately ten feet from a larger concrete uncovered porch area. The uncovered porch area had a small fire pit, several chairs, and empty beer bottles/garbage. There were bullet holes in the outdoor sink as well as one bullet hole in the side privacy fence area. It was later determined two rounds went into the concrete wall of an apartment attached to 322 Seminola Blvd. which was occupied at the time.

The owner of the properties at 322 Seminola Blvd. and 324 Seminola Blvd., Mr. John Mai arrived and gave written consent to search the residence for evidence. He completed form CPD-026 "Consent to Search Premises." Mr. Mai said he wished to press charges against the individual who shot at and struck the exterior cement wall at 322 Seminola Blvd. He provided a sworn written statement.

Eric Brothers with Seminole County Forensic Services responded to 324 Seminola Blvd. to process the scene. Investigator Brothers photographed the interior and exterior of the residence and collected the shell casings. Suspected blood was collected from the front door area where Mr. Jackson was said to have been sitting when paramedics arrived. There was also suspected blood located in the common area near an empty linen closet which was also swabbed and collected. There were no signs of forced entry to the residence. The backyard area of the residence was searched for further evidence with negative results.

An attempt was made to make contact with Eric Wright with negative results. Sgt. Ball attempted to contact Mr. Wright's Mother by telephone, also with negative results.

On 03/03/2014 at approx. 1400 hrs. Det. Willis met with the victim, Patrick Jackson at ORM. Mr. Jackson said he has known Eric Wright for eight months to a year and both lived at 324 Seminola Blvd. at the same time. Mr. Jackson said he met Mr. Wright when he placed a Craigslist ad for a roommate almost a year ago. Mr. Jackson said Mr. Wright was asked to leave the residence approx. two months ago because he was not paying his share of the rent. Mr. Jackson said Mr. Wright still came by the house frequently even after he moved out.

Det. Willis showed Mr. Jackson a photograph of Eric Deshawn Wright (dob. 10/21/1984) and he positively identified him as the person who shot him twice. The photograph was submitted to CPD Property/Evidence.

An Arrest Warrant was obtained for Eric Deshawn Wright.

Eric Wright was arrested on 03/19/14 by the Orange County Sheriff's Office and is currently being held at the Orange County Jail.
