AND against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.

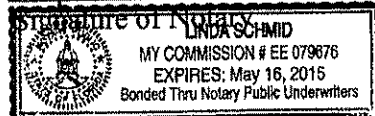

On the above date and approximate time listed above Mr. Haynes (defendant) was seen by Wal-Mart Lost Prevention selecting an item from the electronics section, remove it from its original packaging and conceal it on his person.

Mr. Haynes then walked to the front of the store and purchased a soda but did not pay for the electronic item he concealed on his person. Mr. Haynes then walked towards the stores exit passing all points of sale without attempting to pay for the item.

NARRATIVE**Section 1: Narrative**

On Wednesday August 20, 2014 at approximately 1537 hours, I responded to Wal-Mart located at 1500 East Merritt Island Causeway, Merritt Island, Brevard County, Florida in reference to a retail theft.

Upon my arrival I made contact with Mr. Kerry Willey (Reportee). Mr. Willey stated that at approximately 1530 hours he observed a black male, later identified as Mr. Anthony Haynes (Arrestee), in the electronics section acting suspicious. Mr. Willey informed me Mr. Haynes selected an item from the electronics department then left that area. Mr. Willey stated Mr. Haynes walked to the grocery section of the store and took item he removed from the electronic section out of its package and left the package in the isle. Mr. Willey informed me Mr. Haynes made his way to the front of the store to a cash register. Mr. Willey stated that at the register Mr. Haynes selected a soda and paid for it at the register. Mr. Willey informed me that Mr. Haynes made no attempt to pay for the item he took from the electronics department and made his way towards the exit passing all points of sale without attempting to pay for that it. Mr. Willey then approached Mr. Haynes and brought him back to his office and contacted the Brevard County Sheriff's Office.

Mr. Willey completed a BCSO General Statement Affidavit, BCSO Burglary Theft Affidavit, and a BCSO Property Receipt.

I then made contact with Mr. Haynes and he stated that he did not want to speak to me about this incident.

It should be noted that Mr. Haynes charge was upgraded to a felony based on his prior theft convictions: 2007-MM-05944, petit theft property more than \$100 less than \$300; 2007-MM-062550, petit theft less than \$300; 2007-CF-062638, petit theft property more than \$100 less than \$300; 2011-CF-038364, felony petit theft 2 or more prior theft convictions; 2011-CF-017494, felony petit theft 2 or more prior theft convictions.
