

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA

In The Circuit Court Of The Eighteenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida for Brevard County, at the Fall Term thereof, in the year of our Lord, two thousand and seven, the Grand Jurors of the State of Florida, inquiring in and for the body of the County of Brevard, upon their oaths do charge that:

COUNT 1: IN THE COUNTY OF BREVARD, STATE OF FLORIDA, on November 19, 2007, NELSON PINERO, ALEJANDRO VALDES, RAYDEL ALVAREZ did unlawfully kill a human being, JOSE CARLOS CORCHO, by SHOOTING JOSE CARLOS CORCHO; and said killing was perpetrated by NELSON PINERO, ALEJANDRO VALDES, RAYDEL ALVAREZ from a premeditated design to effect the death of JOSE CARLOS CORCHO, and during the commission of said offense, NELSON PINERO, RAYDEL ALVAREZ each actually possessed a firearm as defined in Section 790.001, Florida Statutes, and further, during the commission of said felony, RAYDEL ALVAREZ discharged said firearm, and as the result of the discharge, did inflict death upon any person, contrary to Sections 782.04(1)(a), 775.087(2)(a)1, 775.087(2)(a)2, 775.087(2)(a)3, Florida Statutes,

COUNT 2: IN THE COUNTY OF BREVARD, STATE OF FLORIDA, on November 19, 2007, NELSON PINERO, ALEJANDRO VALDES, RAYDEL ALVAREZ did enter a structure, to wit: a dwelling, located at 3915 LAKESIDE LANE, GRANT-VALKARIA, the property of JOSE CARLOS CORCHO, ELIZABETH HERNANDEZ, JENNIFER CORCHO, as owner or custodian, with the intent to commit an offense therein, and in the course of committing said burglary NELSON PINERO, RAYDEL ALVAREZ were armed or became armed with dangerous weapons, to wit: FIREARMS, and during the commission of said offense, NELSON PINERO, RAYDEL ALVAREZ each actually possessed a firearm as defined in Section 790.001, Florida Statutes, and further, during the commission of said felony, RAYDEL ALVAREZ discharged said firearm, and as the result of the discharge, did inflict death upon any person, contrary to Sections 810.02(1)(b), 810.02(2)(b), 810.07, 775.087(2)(a)1, 775.087(2)(a)2, 775.087(2)(a)3, Florida Statutes,

COUNT 3: IN THE COUNTY OF BREVARD, STATE OF FLORIDA, on November 19, 2007, NELSON PINERO, ALEJANDRO VALDES, RAYDEL ALVAREZ did forcibly, by threat, or secretly confine, abduct, imprison, or restrain another person, JOSE CARLOS CORCHO without lawful authority and against HIS will, contrary to Sections 787.02(1)(a), 787.02(2), Florida Statutes,

COUNT 4: IN THE COUNTY OF BREVARD, STATE OF FLORIDA, on November 19, 2007, NELSON PINERO, ALEJANDRO VALDES, RAYDEL ALVAREZ did forcibly, by threat, or secretly confine, abduct, imprison, or restrain another person, JENNIFER CORCHO without lawful authority and against HER will, contrary to Sections 787.02(1)(a), 787.02(2), Florida Statutes,

COUNT 5: IN THE COUNTY OF BREVARD, STATE OF FLORIDA, on November 19, 2007, NELSON PINERO, ALEJANDRO VALDES, RAYDEL ALVAREZ did forcibly, by threat, or secretly confine, abduct, imprison, or restrain another person, ELIZABETH HERNANDEZ without lawful authority and against HER will, contrary to Sections 787.02(1)(a), 787.02(2), Florida Statutes,

COUNT 6: IN THE COUNTY OF BREVARD, STATE OF FLORIDA, on November 19, 2007, NELSON PINERO, ALEJANDRO VALDES, RAYDEL ALVAREZ did, with a deadly weapon, to wit: FIREARM, without intent to kill, intentionally make an unlawful threat, by word or act, to do violence to the person of

ELIZABETH HERNANDEZ, coupled with the apparent ability to do so, and doing some act which created a well-founded fear in ELIZABETH HERNANDEZ that such violence was imminent, and during the commission of said offense, RAYDEL ALVAREZ actually possessed a firearm as defined in Section 790.001, Florida Statutes, contrary to Section 784.021(1)(a), 775.087(2)(a)1, Florida Statutes,

and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida
