Mr. Moxey stated V-1's speed was so fast he felt the need to increase his vehicle's speed and pass an unidentified Tractor-Trailer occupying the outside travel lane of northbound US Highway 1 (State Road 5). Mr. Moxey's actions were intended to clear the inside lane as he concluded V-1 would have collided with his vehicle or the Tractor-Trailer. Mr. Moxey identified V-1 by the color, size and brightly colored bumper stickers affixed on the rear window. After Mr. Moxey changed lanes, V-1 passed his vehicle while continuing northbound at a high rate of speed. Mr. Moxey made visual contact with D-1, who he described as a shirtless white male with dark curly hair. Mr. Moxey increased his vehicle's speed in an attempt to obtain V-1's tag number and call "911", to report the reckless operation of V-1. Mr. Moxey stated V-1 was traveling so fast, that within seconds the vehicle was out of sight. Mr. Moxey continued northbound on US Highway 1 (State Road 5) where he stated within minutes he arrived at the scene of the crash. Mr. Moxey observed V-1 at the crash scene and was certain it was the same vehicle he encountered in the area of State Road 404 (Pineda Causeway). Mr. Moxey stated V-1's interior was filled with smoke from the deployed air bags and observed the shirtless driver (D-1) as the only occupant inside the vehicle. Steven Arnett observed the aftermath of the crash while looking out the west window of the "Furniture Gallery", located on the southeast corner of the intersection. Mr. Arnett stated he heard the impact and observed V-2 sliding across both northbound lanes of US Highway 1 (State Road 5). Mr. Arnett stated he immediately responded to V-2's final rest location. Mr. Arnett stated upon arriving at V-2's location a large male (Mr. Moxey) also arrived. Mr. Moxey stated to Mr. Arnett he was following V-1 for miles trying to obtain a tag number and call "911". Mr. Moxey continued by stating "he knew something bad was going to happen". Mr. Arnett turned his attention towards V-1 and observed a tall shirtless male (D-1) being assisted from V-1. Mr. Arnett continued by stating no additional occupants were observed inside V-1 or being assisted from the V-1. Nyasha Johnson stated she observed the crash from her rear view mirror after traveling southbound on US Highway 1 (State Road 5). Ms. Johnson stated she just crossed the County Road 502 (Barnes Boulevard) intersection while facing a green traffic signal. After stopping her vehicle, Ms. Johnson exited and responded to V-2's final rest location. Ms. Johnson also encountered Mr. Moxey who she describes as being clearly upset. Ms. Johnson also hears Mr. Moxey stating he attempted to obtain a tag number from V-1 to alert law enforcement to prevent the crash. Ms. Johnson stated she observed a shirtless causation male being assisted from V-1 and no additional occupants were inside the vehicle. Allen King was stopped eastbound on County Road 502 (Barnes Boulevard) for the red traffic signal to travel southbound on US Highway 1 (State Road 5). Mr. King turns his attention towards the location of the crash after observing a vehicle traveling northbound on US Highway 1 (State Road 5), at a high rate of speed. Mr. King observed V-2 stopped in the inside lane of northbound US Highway 1 (State Road 5), for the red traffic signal. Mr. King hears a loud bang as the collision occurs. Mr. King stated V-2 was at a complete stop when V-1 collided with V-2. Mr. King estimated V-1's speed at impact to be 70 plus miles per hour. After concluding the initial scene investigation, Trooper Daniel J. Davis responded to Wuesthoff Hospital, in Rockledge,



Florida. Trooper Davis continued his investigation by obtaining driver's information and insurance for the vehicles involved in the crash. Trooper Davis asked D-1 for his name, in which D-1 replied Patrick Valenti. Trooper Davis asked D-1, what had happened in the crash. D-1 replied by saying "the man just stopped in front of me". Trooper Davis asked D-1 the color of the traffic signal at the crash scene. D-1 replied by saying there was no light. During Trooper Davis's interaction with D-1, he observed D-1's eyes and noted "Pin Point" pupils. Trooper Davis also noted slurred speech when D-1 was responding to questions. Trooper Davis did not smell any odor of an alcoholic beverage while talking with D-1. Trooper Davis inquired if D-1 was taking any medication, which D-1 replied by saying "no". Based on Trooper Davis's training and experience in the detection of impaired drivers, Trooper Davis concluded D-1 appeared to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol. After providing D-1 with the driver's exchange of information, Trooper Davis informed D-1 he concluded the crash investigation and was now conducting a criminal investigation. Trooper Davis informed D-1 of his "Miranda" rights and requested D-1 submit to a blood test to determine the presence of alcohol or drugs. D-1 agreed to provide a blood sample which Trooper Davis entered into evidence at the Cocoa Florida Highway Patrol Station. D-1 blood sample was forwarded to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement Crime Laboratory for testing. On December 18, 2012, at 7:00 AM, I received the results of the drug testing, which indicated Methadone, Alprazolam and Temazepam were detected in D-1's blood sample which was submitted to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement for testing, by Trooper Davis.

On October 7, 2012, at 11:25 AM, I read aloud D-1's "Miranda Warning" and requested he read aloud the paragraph which followed, which in summary stated he understood his rights. While being recorded and under oath, D-1 stated he ingests the following medications, Methadone, Oxycodone, Zanaflex and Xanax, three times daily. D-1 continued by stating he was taking a variation of these medications for approximately nine years. Based on V-1's driving pattern observed by Mr. Moxey, prior to the crash and the estimated speed of V-1 at 100 miles per hour. Mr. King's estimated speed of V-1 at 70 plus miles per hour, just prior to the impact. Trooper Davis's observation of D-1, based on his training and experience in the detection of impaired drivers, the toxicology report generated by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement's Crime Laboratory, the fact Jackson Hill was a "Quick Child" as defined by Florida Statute and the injuries sustained to D-2 as a result of the crash, caused the chain of events which led to the death of (Quick Child) Jackson Hill.

The results of my investigation it appears D-1 violated the following: Florida Statutes 316.192(1)(3)(a)(b)(c)2: Reckless Driving, which states "Reckless Driving" is any person who drives any vehicle in a willful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property is guilty of reckless driving. Any person who is in violation of subsection (1), who operated a vehicle who, by reason of such operation, causes serious bodily injury to another commits a felony of the third degree. Based on the statements by Mr. King, V-2 was at a complete stop in the northbound inside of US Highway 1 (State Road 5) for a red traffic signal. D-1 failed to make any attempt to slow or stop as required by Florida Statute, causing the right front of V-1 to collide with the left rear of V-2. The collision caused serious bodily injuries to D-2's head and blunt impact to her lower torso, causing a rupture of the Placenta. The ruptured Placenta caused her to undergo an emergency "Cesarean-Section". The observations by Mr. Moxey and Mr. King conclude D-1 was in violation of exceeding the posted speed limit of 55 miles per hour, an unsafe or improper attempted lane change and failure to stop. These violations were committed in a willful and wanton manner without regard for the safety of D-2, or the other traffic traveling on the roadway. Florida Statute 316.193(3)(a)(a)(b)(c)1: DUI with property damage, which states any person in violation of subsection (1); who operates a vehicle; and who by reason of such operation, causes or contributes to causing: damage to the property or person of another commits a misdemeanor of the first degree. D-1 clearly violated this statute by operating V-1 and colliding with the legally stopped V-2. The collision resulted in an estimated \$10,000.00 of property damage to V-2 which was legally registered to Todd Lewis Hill of 2214 Hawthorne Avenue, Rockledge, Florida 32955.

Florida Statute 316.193(1)(a): DUI, which states a person is guilty of the offence of driving under the influence and the person is under the influence of any chemical substance set forth in section 877.111, or any substance controlled under chapter 893, when affected to the extent that the person's normal faculties are impaired. The observation of D-1's driving pattern by the witnesses, which resulted in the collision and the observations by Trooper Davis, who is trained and experienced in the detection of impaired drivers, would clearly indicate D-1 violated this statute. Florida Statute 316.193(3)(a)(b)(c)3: DUI Manslaughter, which states a person is guilty of the offense of driving under the influence, if the person is driving or in actual physical control of a vehicle within this state and the person is under the influence of any chemical substance set forth in s.877.111, or any substance controlled under chapter 893, when affected to the extent that the person's normal faculties are impaired, and causes the death of any human being or unborn quick child commits DUI Manslaughter. D-1 was in clear violation of this statute by operating V-1 in a reckless manner by exceeding the posted speed limit, making no attempt to slow or stop V-1 prior to colliding with the rear of V-2, which was legally stopped in the inside lane of northbound US Highway 1 (State Road 5), for a red traffic signal. The Florida Department of Law Enforcement Crime Laboratory identified Methadone, Alprazolam and Temazepam in the blood samples obtained from D-1 by Trooper Davis. Based on Trooper Davis's training and experience in the detection of impaired drivers, led him to believe D-1 was impaired based on his observations of the D-1 while at Wuesthoff Hospital. After concluding D-1 appeared to be impaired, Trooper Davis informed D-1 he was conducting a criminal investigation and requested a blood sample for testing. The three drugs identified in D-1's blood sample could each cause a normally functioning person's faculties to be impaired; the combination of all three drugs would enhance D-1's lack of judgment and certain impairment. The drugs identified in the sample are considered "Schedule II Controlled Substances" by Florida Statute, which indicates the drugs have a high potential for abuse which may lead to severe psychological or physical dependence. D-1's failure to observe V-2 legally stopped in the inside lane and additional vehicles traveling on US Highway 1 (State Road 5), would indicate a clear lack of judgment and a certain degree of impairment. Florida Statute 782.071 Vehicular Homicide, which states vehicular homicide, is the killing of a human being, or the killing of a viable fetus (Quick Child) by any injury to the mother, caused by the operation of a motor vehicle by another in a reckless manner likely to cause the death of, or great bodily harm to, another. D-1 was in clear violation of the vehicular homicide statute, by operating V-1 at speeds greater than the posted speed limit, which was first observed by Mr. Moxey while traveling northbound on US Highway 1 (State Road 5), prior to the crash. Mr. Moxey, after first observing V-1 in the area of State Road 404 (Pineda Causeway), felt the need to clear the inside northbound lane where he was traveling to prevent a collision with the fast approaching V-1. Mr. Moxey attempted to increase the speed of his vehicle to obtain V-1's tag number. Mr. Moxey stated V-1 was traveling northbound on US Highway 1 (State Road 5) so fast; it was out of visual sight within seconds. Mr. Moxey estimated V-1's speed to be at 100 miles per hour as it passed his vehicle. Mr. King was stopped eastbound on County Road 502 (Barnes Boulevard), when he caught a glance of V-1 just prior to impact. Mr. King turned his attention towards V-2, where he stated was at a complete stop in the inside lane of northbound US Highway 1 (State Road 5). Mr. King estimated V-1's speed at "70 plus" miles per hour when V-1's right front collided with the left rear of V-2. The result of the collision caused head and lower torso injuries to D-2. The lower torso injuries caused a rupture to D-2's Placenta, which resulted in an emergency "Cesarean Section" while at Wuesthoff Hospital. On September 6, 2012, D-2 was examined by Doctor Mark S. McTammany at 9:04 AM. Doctor McTammany's examination report indicated the fetal active as normal. This examination was conducted approximately one hour and ten minutes prior to the crash. This would conclude D-2's fetus (Quick Child) was viable with no abnormalities. The emergency "Cesarean Section" resulted in the birth of D-2's son (Quick Child) Jackson Hill.
