ASSISTANT STATE ATTORNEY, CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1: IN THE COUNTY OF BREVARD, STATE OF FLORIDA, on September 6, 2012,
PATRICK RICHARD VALENTI, did drive or was in actual physical control of a vehicle while
under the influence of alcoholic beverages, any chemical substance set forth in Section 877.111,
Florida Statutes, or any substance controlled under Chapter 893, Florida Statutes, when affected
to the extent that said person's normal faculties were impaired, or while having a blood-alcohol
level of .08 or more grams of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood, or a breath-alcohol level of .08
or more grams of alcohol per 210 liters of breath, and by reason of such operation of a vehicle
did cause or contribute to causing the death of a human being, JACKSON HILL, contrary to
Sections 316.193(1), 316.193(3)(c)3.a., Florida Statutes,

COUNT 2: IN THE COUNTY OF BREVARD, STATE OF FLORIDA, on September 6, 2012,
PATRICK RICHARD VALENTI did kill a human being, JACKSON HILL, by the operation of
a motor vehicle in a reckless manner likely to cause death or great bodily harm to another,
contrary to Section 782.071, Florida Statutes,

COUNT 3: IN THE COUNTY OF BREVARD, STATE OF FLORIDA, on September 6, 2012,
PATRICK RICHARD VALENTI did drive a vehicle in willful or wanton disregard for the safety
of persons or property, and by reason of such operation, caused serious bodily injury to another,
AMBER HILL, contrary to Sections 316.192(1), 316.192(3)2., Florida Statutes,

COUNT 4: IN THE COUNTY OF BREVARD, STATE OF FLORIDA, on September 6, 2012,
PATRICK RICHARD VALENTI, did drive or be in actual physical control of a vehicle while
under the influence of alcoholic beverages, any chemical substance set forth in Section 877.111,
Florida Statutes, or any substance controlled under Chapter 893, Florida Statutes, when affected
to the extent that said person's normal faculties were impaired, or while having a blood-alcohol
level of .08 or more grams of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood, or a breath-alcohol level of .08

COUNT 5: IN THE COUNTY OF BREVARD, STATE OF FLORIDA, on September 6, 2012, PATRICK RICHARD VALENTI, did drive or was in actual physical control of a vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic beverages, any chemical substance set forth in section 877.111, Florida Statutes, or any substance controlled under Chapter 893, Florida Statutes, when affected to the extent that said person's normal faculties were impaired, or while having a blood-alcohol level of .08 or more grams of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood, or while having a breath-alcohol level of .08 or more grams of alcohol per 210 liters of breath, and by reason of the operation of said vehicle did cause or contribute to causing damage to the property of TODD LEWIS HILL, contrary to sections 316.193(1), 316.193(3)(a)(b)(c)1., Florida Statutes,

AND against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.
