On July 5, 2014 officers were dispatched to the 7-11 located at 340 Douglas Ave in reference to a shooting. Once on scene Officer Church made contact with the witness, Devontae Strickland (D. Strickland). D. Strickland stated that his cousin was shot while driving on I.4. D. Strickland further stated that the shooter along with two other females were still in the car. Due to his injuries, D. Strickland was transported to the South Seminole Hospital.

While Officer Church was speaking with D. Strickland, Seminole County Dispatch advised of a reckless vehicle on I.4. Officers were advised that the vehicle had crash and multiple people were fleeing the scene of the crash. It was further advised that someone jumped out of the vehicle while it was moving and someone was shot inside of the vehicle. Because of the time frame it was determined that D. Strickland was involved with this incident.

At this time Deputy Astor arrived on scene at the crash and he saw a black male hiding in the area. Deputy Astor was able to get the black male into investigative custody. The black male was identified as Junior Gedeon (J. Gedeon). J. Gedeon was transported to the Florida Hospital of Altamonte due to injuries he sustained in the crash.

While on scene at the crash, officers were able to see a black male slumped over in the front passenger seat of the vehicle. Seminole County Fire and Rescue were called to the scene however the male pronounced dead.

Officers began to canvass the area and they were able to locate two black females walking away from the crash scene. Upon contact

with the officers, the females, Jeanette Littles (J. Littles) and Antanesia Smith (A. Smith) advised they were involved in a shooting which took place inside of a vehicle. J. Littles and A. Smith were transported to the nearby gas station, Shell which is located at 91 W SR 436. At this time I arrived on scene at the Shell gas station as the on-duty detective.

At the scene I was able to see that J. Littles had blood on her shirt, pants, and a handkerchief which was in her hand. The handkerchief appeared to match the American flag. After observing J. Littles I made contact with A. Smith. I advised A. Smith that I needed to speak with her and that she would be transported to the Altamonte Springs Police Department for an interview. A. Smith declined.

At this time I asked A. Smith why she was reluctant to help and she advised that she and her mother had been through a lot and that they needed to go home. A. Smith stated that "Junior" (J. Gedeon) knew where they lived. A. Smith stated that the victim's family also knew where they lived. I then asked A. Smith if she was to speak with me inside of my vehicle and she advised she would however she did not want to write anything down.

Once inside of my vehicle I advised A. Smith that I needed an entire accounting of what happened during the night which led to the shooting. A. Smith stated that on the late hours of July 4, 2014, she, J. Littles, and J. Littles, boyfriend, Junior and two other males she did not know went to club Glitz. A. Smith described one of the males as "the guy in the red shirt." The other male was identified as Rodney Porter (R. Porter). A. Smith stated that Junior spent the whole day trying to make plans and he was calling anyone he could to go to the clubs with them. While at club Glitz, Junior began acting very aggressive towards everyone who was at the club. A. Smith stated Junior had been drinking throughout the night however she was unsure if he was on some sort of drug.

Because Junior began making a scene, A. Smith along with Junior, J. Littles, and one of the males, R. Porter left the club. A. Smith started they attempted to look for the guy in the red shirt however they were unable to and therefore they left him at the club. A short time after A. Smith, J. Littles, Junior, and R. Porter arrive at another club called Santé Fe. A. Smith stated that the group never went inside because there was a large enough presence of people in the parking lot of the club that they could socialize with.

While at the parking lot, Junior continued acting aggressive towards people. A short time after the guy in the red shirt arrived and he got into a verbal confrontation with everyone for leaving him at the previous club. At this time Junior became so upset that they needed to leave once again. A. Smith stated the guy with the red shirt remained at the club. The group left to a nearby Auto Zone where R. Porter made contact with a group of individuals. R. Porter had stated one of the males was his cousin. Junior at this time got into an altercation with the group and they left the scene to go home. R. Porter stated that he had too much to drink therefore he needed to pick up his cousin, D. Strickland to give them a ride back to Sanford. A. Smith stated that they drove into the Orlando Rio neighborhood to pick D. Strickland up.

D. Strickland began driving the vehicle while, as R. Porter sat in the front passenger seat, Junior sat in the middle seat while A. Smith sat to the left of Junior and J. Littles sat to the right of him. As they passed under the Wymore Bridge on I. 4 in the Altamonte Springs city limits, A. Smith stated she heard a gunshot in the vehicle. A. Smith stated she then saw J. Littles and Junior wrestling in the back seat. Junior had a gun in between his legs. D. Strickland jumped out of the vehicle as J. Littles attempted to grab the steering wheel to prevent the vehicle from crashing. The vehicle crashed a short time after and she and J. Littles began running from the scene before officers made contact with them. This interview was audio recorded and Detective VanCleave was also present.

Due to J. Littles having blood on her she was transported to the Altamonte Springs Police Department. A. Smith also went to the Altamonte Springs Police Department. Due to A. Smith personally knowing Junior, I showed her a café photograph of J. Gedeon at which time A. Smith stated he was the person in the vehicle with them.

I then made contact with J. Littles in the Criminal Investigations interview room and she advised that on July 4, 2014 she along with A. Smith and J. Gedeon were picked up by two of his friends she did not recognize. J. Littles stated that one of the males was wearing a red shirt. The other male was identified as Rodney Porter. J. Littles stated that J. Gedeon was upset the entire night. They first went to a club in Orlando where J. Gedeon got into several arguments with people. Due to J. Gedeon's demeanor, they left the club and went to another club in the Pine Hills area. J. Littles stated they were unable to locate the guy in the red shirt and therefore they left him at the club.

While in the parking lot of the second club, the guy in the red shirt arrived and he became confrontational with J. Gedeon. J. Littles stated she along with A. Smith and R. Porter helped J. Gedeon into the vehicle and they drove to a nearby Auto zone parking lot. R. Porter met with several individuals who he stated were his cousins. J. Gedeon at this time became confrontational with the group and at this point J. Little asked R Porter to take them home. R. Porter stated he was willing however he had too much to drink and therefore he needed to pick up his cousin, D. Strickland to give them a ride back to Sanford.

Upon picking up D. Strickland, R. Porter sat in the front passenger seat while D. Strickland drove the vehicle. J. Littles stated that she sat to the right of J. Gedeon in the back seat while A. Smith sat to the left of him. J. Littles stated that she was so embarrassed by the way J. Gedeon acting that she was looking out of the window and not speaking to him. J. Littles stated that R. Porter received several phone calls from someone who stated they were going to kill J. Gedeon. J. Littles stated it was possibly one of the males that J. Gedeon got into the altercation with at the AutoZone. J. Gedeon at this time became very agitated.

As D. Strickland was driving, J. Littles saw him remove a gun from the left driver side seat and he handed it to R. Porter. R. Porter then received another phone call. R. Porter began speaking with an unknown female about his children. J. Littles stated R. Porter was

making plans to take his children to Chuck e Chesses. After hanging up the phone with the female, R. Porter advised J. Gedeon to try and calm down since he did not want any problems. R. Porter stated he lived for his family and he did not need any trouble. R. Porter stated his cousin was the person who stated he was going to kill him.

As J. Littles was staring out of the window she heard a loud bang she recognized as a gunshot. J. Littles saw R. Porter slumped in his chair and she saw a gun in between J. Gedeon's legs. At this time she began wrestling with J. Gedeon to prevent him from shooting once again. D. Strickland at this time lost control of the vehicle at which time J. Littles grabbed the steering wheel to get the vehicle under control. D. Strickland jumped out of the vehicle at this time and it crashed on I. 4 shortly before the 434 exit. J. Gedeon at this time ran from the scene. J. Littles and A. Smith then fled from the scene and a short time after officers made contact with them.

After speaking with J. Littles, I showed her a café photograph of J. Gedeon at which time she positively identified him as her boyfriend. Due to the blood on her clothing J. Littles was photographed. J. Littles was then handed a plastic jump suit to wear. J. Littles was escorted to the Criminal Investigations briefing room where she changed her clothing. The briefing room is a secured room with no recording devices. After J. Littles was finished changing she placed her clothing and the handkerchief in a evidence bag.

J. Littles was then reunited with A. Smalls. Both were asked if they needed family called however they advised they did not have any information on hand to call them. A taxi service was then called and they both left the scene. The interview with J. Littles was video and audio recorded and will be entered into evidence. Detective VanCleave was also present for the interview.

After speaking with J. Littles I was advised that J. Gedeon was cleared from the Florida Hospital of Altamonte. J. Gedeon was transported to the Altamonte Springs Police Department by Police Officer First Class Baker. Upon arriving at the Altamonte Springs Police Department, J. Gedeon was placed in the Criminal Investigations interview room. J. Gedeon was advised of his Miranda Warning from an Altamonte Springs Police Department Miranda Warning card. Detective VanCleave was also present. I asked J. Gedeon if he was willing to speak with me and he nodded his head and he advised that on July 5, 2014 he along with J. Littles, A. Smith and a friend of his were going to Orlando to pick up his children. I asked J. Gedeon what time of night it was and he advised he didn't care. J. Gedeon stated his ex-girlfriend had his children in hiding and he knew she would be at the clubs so he had his opportunity to take his children.

J. Gedeon stated that he was going to meet a friend in Orlando who would give him a ride back home once he got his children. J. Gedeon stated he only knew his friend by nickname. J. Gedeon stated that as they were driving someone started shooting at their vehicle. J. Gedeon stated the vehicle then crashed and he fled the scene. J. Gedeon stated he knew the driver and passage as "Dread" and "Killa". J. Gedeon stated that he knew both males were into robbing people and he felt the shooting could have been retaliation. J. Gedeon then fled the area because he was on house arrest and he did not want to have any contact with the police.

J. Gedeon was advised that his account of what happened was not consistent with the evidence at the scene. I asked J. Gedeon if he went to the clubs and he advised he had not. I asked J. Gedeon if he went to the AutoZone parking lot and he advised he had not. I asked J. Gedeon if he got into an altercation with anyone and he advised he had not. I asked J. Gedeon if he was arguing with J. Littles and he advised he had not.

J. Gedeon was advised that the vehicle was located on I. 4 heading east bound and therefore his accounting of heading to Orlando was inconsistent because they vehicle would have had to have been driving west bound on I.4. I then advised J. Gedeon that witnesses stated he was at the clubs and he had altercations with several individuals. J. Gedeon stated he wanted to know who. J. Gedeon was not advised.

J. Gedeon at this time asked Detective VanCleave to leave the interview room as he only wanted to speak with me. Detective VanCleave left the room and J. Gedeon stated that the truth was he did go to the clubs. J. Gedeon stated that as they were driving to Sanford a vehicle shot at them. J. Gedeon stated he was not paying attention to the traffic on I.4 so he did not see the vehicle that shot at them. J. Gedeon stated the road was full of vehicles however.

I once again advised J. Gedeon that his accounting of the situation was in probable as the vehicle did not have any damage which would have implied a gunshot coming from outside of the vehicle. I asked J. Gedeon if something happened between him and the driver or passenger and he advised no.

I advised J. Gedeon that I did not believe him due to the fact that the gunshot came from inside of the vehicle, because he initially lied before, and because the witness statements were not consistent with his accounting of the incident. I asked J. Gedeon to be honest because I wanted his side of the story. J. Gedeon paused for several long seconds before I

J. Gedeon stated that he got into an altercation with family members of R. Porter at the club. J. Gedeon stated that Dread (R. Porter) and Killa (D. Strickland) were known killers in Orlando and he was fully aware of what they were capable of. J. Gedeon advised they were not aware of what he was capable of. J. Gedeon stated that Dread's (R. Porter) cousin was hitting on J. Littles and he felt it was disrespectful to him. While driving back to Sanford on I.4 Dread (R. Porter) advised him that his cousin wanted to kill him. J. Gedeon stated he wasn't worried because it was just talk.

J. Gedeon then stated that he saw Killa (D. Strickland) reaching over and J. Gedeon became nervous. J. Gedeon stated he was not sure if Killa (D. Strickland) was reaching for a gun, knife, or a Black and Mild cigar. J. Gedeon stated due to their reputation, because he

was disrespected by them and because he did not know what was going on in the front of the vehicle he took

J. Gedeon stated at this time the vehicle crashed and the air bag was deployed. J. Gedeon advised J. Littles and A. Smith to stay in the vehicle because they needed to leave however they fled from the scene. J. Gedeon stated he fled from the vehicle and he was caught a short time after.



J. Gedeon described J. Smalls' gun as a chrome 380 handgun. At this time J. Gedeon was ran through the Corrections Offender Network and we were able to see that he was on probation in Orange County for a felony conviction which occurred on December 2, 2012. The scheduled termination date of the probation is September 15, 2015.

Due to J. Gedeon's ~~charging him with homicide, first degree murder, Florida State Statue 782.04(1a1).~~ Due to J. Gedeon being convicted of felony possession of MDMA, I am charging him with possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, Florida State Statue 790.23(1a). Due to J. Gedeon firing a gun within the vehicle, I am charging him with direct discharge of a firearm from a vehicle, Florida State Statue 790.15(3). J. Gedeon was placed under arrest and he was transported to the Seminole County Jail for processing.
